

MILLING

Standard thickness is 3/4" solid. Tongue-and-groove, end matched and micro beveled.

STANDARD WIDTHS

Standard widths are 2-1/4", 3-1/4", 4" or 5" for domestics, and 3-1/4" for exotics. Standards lengths are 1' to 8' for domestics, and 1' to 7' for exotics.

BOX SIZES

Domestic 2-1/4" comes 23 sq. ft. per box.

Domestic 3-1/4" comes 20.75 sq. ft. per box.

Domestic 4" comes 20.5 sq. ft. per box.

Domestic 5" comes 25.5 sq. ft. per box.

Exotic 3" comes 20 sq. ft. per box.


